Meanwhile, the Argentine Jorge Luis Borges, though a contemporary, rejected sentimentality—his metaphysical labyrinths opposing Neruda's visceral immediacy. In contrast, the Mexican poet Octavio Paz, while critical of Neruda's late romanticism, acknowledged the sonnets' power to "make the personal political without reducing it." This cross-pollination of approaches underscores the sonnets' place within a vibrant, contested Latin American literary field. From an industry perspective, the sonnets transformed Neruda's market. Posthumously, they became foundational to Latin American literary canonization, driving demand for critical editions, translations, and academic study. The 1975 Chilean reissue, published under pseudonyms during martial law, became a clandestine bestseller—proof of their role as cultural currency under repression. Today, they dominate university syllabi from Paris to Mexico City, their translations shaping global perceptions of Latin American identity. Expert projections emphasize their enduring relevance. Cultural historian Elena Martínez notes: "Neruda's sonnets endure because they articulate a universal condition—love as both vulnerability and resistance—within a specific, traumatized context. In an age of rising authoritarianism and ecological crisis, they remind us that personal stories are never apolitical." Their
