The 2022 cyberattack on a Kent NHS trust, which temporarily disrupted SharePoint-based appointment systems, underscored vulnerabilities in third-party integrations and user access management. In response, the council has adopted zero-trust architecture principles, embedding multi-factor authentication, continuous monitoring, and automated threat detection across all SharePoint instances. Long-term implications suggest a trajectory toward SharePoint evolving into a central nervous system for Kent's digital public services. Its role will expand beyond document management to orchestrate real-time decision-making across emergency response, environmental monitoring, and social welfare.
