In East Pakistan, under West Pakistani dominance, Bengali was marginalized, and its vernacular expressions—including swear words—became markers of ethnic and political resistance. The 1952 Language Movement, a pivotal struggle for cultural recognition, saw swearing not just in protest slogans but in street rallies, where phrases like **“shutki khutte”** (a vulgar term meaning “fucking fool”) or **“mokhiya bhut”** (literally “corpse demon,” used as a death threat) transformed from private slang into public defiance. The suppression of Bengali in education and media amplified the power of vernacular slurs—now spoken not just as insults, but as declarations of sovereignty. Post-independence Bangladesh (1971) and West Bengal’s trajectory within India further shaped these linguistic forms. In Bangladesh, state-led language purification campaigns sought to eliminate colonial and “impure” elements, yet street vernacular thrived, absorbing new layers. Urban youth in Dhaka, amid economic precarity and political volatility, developed a hybrid register—mixing classical Bengali

traditions further enriched the lexicon. Oral storytelling, particularly in rural Bengal, thrived on hyperbolic language to dramatize conflict and justice. If a person betrayed a community, say, **“*tumi mukh kehte hai*” (“you spoil the face”) functioned not just as insult but as a cosmic indictment—implying not just social shame but a rupture in communal harmony.
