The “inside” was defined by clearance, loyalty, and interoperability; the “outside” included foreign governments, unofficial channels, and adversaries' networks. But beyond physical borders, the worksheet encoded epistemological boundaries: what facts were validated, who could speak, and which voices were excluded from the record. This duality—spatial and epistemic—became foundational. The framework expanded beyond intelligence with the rise of global finance and multinational corporations in the 1970s and 1980s.
