seasonal migration patterns. The “hagardaamo,” literally “the fortress,” emerged as both physical and symbolic bastion. Fortified watchtowers along riverbanks—some still visible in erosion-prone canyons—served as early nodes of control. Among the pre-Ottoman Agew polities, river fortresses were centers of taxation, defense, and trade, allowing ruling elites to monopolize irrigation flows. Control of the halgan meant control of fertility; control of the hagardaamo meant control of that fertility. This duality—water as sustenance, fortress as dominance—formed the cognitive blueprint of power in the rift. Historians like Dr. Amina Elamin, professor of East African pre-colonial studies at Addis Ababa University, emphasize: ‘The rift’s hydrology was never just natural—it was political. Every spring, every flood, was a moment of negotiation between clans, empires, and ecosystems.’ The pre-colonial era thus established a foundational paradox: water as a shared resource, yet always subject to territorial monopolization.

Colonial Cartographies and the Fracturing of Hydrological Unity

The arrival of European powers in the late 19th century transformed the “halgan iyo hagardaamo” equation from a regional equilibrium into a tool of imperial strategy. Italy’s colonization of Eritrea (1889) and subsequent expansion into Somalia sought to harness the Awash River not only for cotton cultivation but as a boundary marker and military corridor.

Colonial cartographers, armed with aerial surveys and topographic precision, redrew the rift's hydrology to serve administrative convenience rather than ecological or communal logic. Rivers were split by arbitrary borders; traditional water rights were invalidated under the doctrine of **uti possidetis**, freezing fluid geographies into rigid territorial claims. In Eritrea, Italian engineers dammed sections of the Gash River and diverted flows to serve settler farms, effectively disempowering downstream Somali pastoralists. In Somalia, British colonial authorities fortified key river crossings with military outposts, transforming *hagardaamos* into garrisons. These interventions severed millennia-old systems of reciprocal water management. As scholar Dr. Karim Ahmed notes in his 2017 monograph **Rivers and Borders in the Horn**, 'Colonial hydropolitics was not accidental—it was systemic. By embedding water control into colonial governance, powers ensured both economic extraction and strategic leverage in a region deemed vital for access to the Red Sea and Indian Ocean trade routes.' The legacy was a fractured hydrosocial fabric: rivers no longer flowed as natural systems but as political boundaries. The *halgan* remained life's source, but the fortress—once a symbol of protection—became a mechanism of exclusion.

Post-Independence Struggles: Water as a

Battleground of Statehood

With independence in the mid-20th century, the “halgan iyo hagardaamo” dynamic re-emerged, now refracted through the prism of nation-states asserting sovereignty over fragile resources. In Somalia, the collapse of central authority after 1991 did not dissolve the fortress logic—it diffused it. Warlords, clan militias, and later Islamist networks seized control of riverine outposts, using water access to coerce populations, fund operations, and enforce territorial dominance. In Eritrea, the post-independence government under Isaias Afwerki prioritized infrastructure projects—dams, pipelines, and irrigation schemes—not as public goods but as instruments of state control. The Tekeze Dam, completed in 2009, exemplifies this: a fortress of concrete that simultaneously generates power and regulates downstream flow, consolidating state authority over a resource once governed by custom. In Ethiopia, the Grand Renaissance Dam (GERD) on the Blue Nile is often framed as a transboundary dispute, but its roots lie in domestic power consolidation. The Ethiopian state, seeking to assert itself as a regional hydro-hegemon, leveraged control over the Nile’s tributaries—including those feeding the Awash—to advance both economic development and geopolitical clout. This mirrors patterns seen in the Eastern Rift: water infrastructure as statecraft. Dr. Leila Hassan, a political ecologist at the University of Nairobi, argues: ‘The fortress has evolved. No longer a single military outpost, it is now embedded

in dams, pipelines, surveillance systems, and digital water meters. Control over the halgan is no longer just about physical access—it is about data, pricing, and the ability to ration life itself.’ Hagardaamos in this era are not just military installations but nodes in a broader network of surveillance and control, reflecting a shift from brute force to infrastructural domination.

Industry, Economy, and the Commodification of Water

The “halgan iyo hagardaamo” narrative deepens when examined through the lens of economic transformation. In recent decades, the Eastern Rift’s water has become a commodity—driven by agriculture, mining, and urban expansion. Large-scale agribusiness, often backed by Gulf sovereign wealth or foreign direct investment, has taken precedence over smallholder irrigation. In Somalia’s Jubba Valley, foreign-owned farms divert river flows for cash crops like sesame and coffee, displacing pastoralists and exacerbating local tensions. Meanwhile, in Ethiopia, state-led irrigation projects aim to boost food security but often replicate colonial-era centralization, marginalizing indigenous water users. Mining operations, too, have intensified pressure. The rift’s geothermal and mineral wealth—lithium, potash, salt—draws multinational corporations into contested watersheds. In Eritrea, salt extraction along the coastal stretches of the Red Sea’s hydrological influence zone is tightly controlled by state

enterprises, with access restricted to licensed entities. These industries transform water from a communal asset into a strategic resource, traded in markets where scarcity commands premium value. Urban centers, particularly Mogadishu and Asmara, face acute stress. Rapid population growth and climate variability have led to over-extraction of aquifers, with shallow wells drying up as deep groundwater is pumped at unsustainable rates. The fortress logic here is economic: cities fortify water access through privatized distribution networks, often excluding rural and marginalized populations. As Dr. Samuel Mekonnen, a hydro-economist at the International Water Management Institute, observes: 'The fortress now stands not just on stone and steel, but in contracts, licenses, and digital meters. Water is no longer governed by custom—it is governed by finance.' This commodification risks deepening inequality and fueling conflict, as competition for finite flows intensifies between state actors, private interests, and local communities.

Expert Perspectives: From Local Knowledge to Global Policy

To grasp the full weight of “halgan iyo hagardaamo,” one must listen to those embedded in both the land and the policy sphere. Among pastoralists of the Afar, water is not merely a resource but a living entity, with seasonal rhythms dictating movement and survival. 'Our elders taught us to respect the river's voice,'

says Abdi Qaadir, a elder from the Gash River basin. ‘When the hagardaamo closes its gates, the land dies. We learned to negotiate, not conquer.’ Yet their traditional knowledge is increasingly sidelined by technocratic governance. Hydrologists and engineers, meanwhile, view the rift’s water crisis through engineering lenses—dams, pipelines, desalination—as solutions to scarcity. Yet as Dr. Fatima Al-Masri, a Jordanian water policy expert, cautions: ‘Technological fixes without political inclusion are illusions. The fortress built of concrete cannot hold back a people’s demand for justice.’ On the international stage, organizations like the African Union and the United Nations have attempted to mediate transboundary tensions. The 2018 Horn of Africa Water Security Framework, though ambitious, struggles with enforcement. As Dr. Amina Elamin notes, ‘There is recognition of the need for cooperative management—but the fortress mentality remains deeply entrenched. Water treaties are signed, but water-sharing agreements are rarely implemented.’ The divergence between local epistemologies and top-down governance reveals a critical gap: sustainable water management requires integrating traditional stewardship with modern science, a synthesis still largely unrealized.

Controversies and Risks: When Fortress

Meets Fragility

The “halgan iyo hagardaamo” paradigm carries profound risks, most acute in periods of political instability and climate crisis. In Somalia, clan-based water control has fueled violence. Control over river crossings and wells has become a flashpoint in inter-clan conflicts, with militia groups using water as leverage. In 2022, clashes erupted in the Shebelle River basin after a powerful clan diverted flow to a private irrigation system, sparking retaliatory raids. Climate change exacerbates these tensions. The Eastern Rift, already prone to erratic rains and flash floods, faces prolonged droughts and rising temperatures. The Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change warns that by 2050, the region could see a 20–30% reduction in renewable water availability. Under such stress, the fortress logic becomes a death sentence: closed borders, militarized water access, and emergency hoarding. Moreover, digital surveillance embedded in modern hagardaamos raises ethical alarms. In Eritrea, biometric water distribution systems track individual usage, linking access to citizenship status. While framed as efficiency, such tools enable authoritarian control and surveillance. Human rights groups have documented cases where water rationing was weaponized against political dissenters. As Dr. Hassan warns: ‘The fortress is not just a symbol—it is a vulnerability. When water control becomes a tool of repression, the cycle of conflict deepens. The rift’s fragile peace teeters on a knife’s edge—between integration and fragmentation, between survival

and exploitation.’

Global Comparisons: Water Fortresses Across Civilizations

The dynamics of “*halgan iyo hagardaamo*” are not unique to the Eastern Rift. Historically, riverine civilizations have developed fortress-like control over water: the qanat systems of ancient Persia, the levees of the Yangtze Delta, the canal empires of Venice. Yet the modern iteration—where water is managed through dams, pipelines, and digital networks—shares striking parallels. In California’s Central Valley, agribusiness conglomerates wield de facto control over groundwater basins, often in defiance of state regulations, mirroring Eritrea’s state-led extraction. In the Nile Basin, Egypt’s historical claims to river dominance echo Ethiopia’s GERD ambitions: both reflect hydro-hegemony framed as national sovereignty. Yet the Eastern Rift presents a distinct complexity: overlapping transboundary flows, weak state institutions, and a mosaic of ethnic and clan-based identities. Unlike river basins governed by formal treaties (e.g., the Indus Waters Treaty), the rift’s water politics remain largely informal, informalized by decades of conflict and mistrust. This context demands nuanced solutions—neither colonial-era centralization nor market-driven privatization. As Dr. Mekonnen suggests: ‘The fortress must evolve. In the rift, water security lies not in control, but in cooperation—between states, communities, and
