quieter alternative, suggests increasing the bet by one unit after a loss and decreasing by one after a win—balancing aggression with restraint. While less aggressive than Martingale, it fails to close the long-term expectation gap. The Labouchère system, a combinatorial approach using sequences of numbers, introduces pattern recognition but remains bound by the same probabilistic ceiling. Each system assumes a finite window, yet roulette's true danger lies in the long tail: statistically inevitable—except that, in human persistence, it never manifests.
