programs linking thermostat data to district energy management. However, concerns over data localization and foreign technology influence have prompted regulatory scrutiny, forcing Honeywell to adapt its cloud architecture to comply with China's Cybersecurity Law. This regional divergence underscores a central tension: while Honeywell positions its thermostats as universal enablers of energy efficiency, their effectiveness is contingent on local infrastructure, regulatory support, and cultural acceptance of digital automation.
