Her fieldwork spans over thirty countries, from the wreckage of diocesan scandals in Latin America to the flourishing megachurches of Southeast Asia, revealing a paradox: while institutional religion declines in visibility, its narrative influence persists—often amplified by digital platforms that commodify spirituality. Economically, **Books Priest** interrogates the publishing industry’s role in shaping public perception of religion. Free’s work was initially self-published through independent presses before gaining traction via literary festivals and academic circuits—highlighting a broader shift in how marginalized or dissenting religious voices access audiences. Raised in rural Mississippi, her early encounters with faith were mediated through sermons that blended Black Southern theology with a rigid moral order—one that emphasized obedience, silence, and the sanctity of tradition. Yet, even then, Free sensed a dissonance: the words spoken with fervor often masked histories of exclusion, silence, and complicity. Her ordination in 2012, after years of theological study and pastoral work, marked a formal entry into the priesthood, but also the beginning of a deeper disillusionment. As she navigated institutional hierarchies, she witnessed firsthand how doctrine, when disconnected from lived experience, becomes a shield against accountability. The idea for **Books Priest** crystallized during a period of profound personal loss.
