Expert Perspectives: Visionaries, Skeptics, and the Ethics of Control

Leading experts offer divergent views on Wexler and the Library. Dr. Elena Rostova, a professor of cyber-ethics at the University of Helsinki, describes him as “a prophet of epistemic responsibility.” She argues that Wexler “foresaw the moment when information would become the ultimate currency—and recognized that sovereign control over meaning is the new geopolitical frontier.” Yet she warns: “The Library’s power lies in its duality.
