But this influence demands vigilance: whose history is being taught, and whose is being omitted? The textbook's editorial choices shape not only curricula but national identities, making its global dissemination both a tool of empowerment and a vector of cultural influence.

The ripple effects of McGraw Hill's World History 6th grade extend far beyond classroom walls.
