For instance, the chapter on "Gender and Sexuality" does not treat gender as an isolated category but traces its intersection with racial capitalism—how Black women's labor has historically been devalued through both racial exclusion and gendered exploitation, from plantation economies to contemporary service industries. Similarly, the treatment of migration is reframed not as a policy issue but as a structural outcome of neocolonial economic extraction, where global labor flows reinforce a hierarchy of human worth. Geopolitically, the 13th edition situates these dynamics within a globalizing world order marked by asymmetry. The collapse of Soviet bloc ideologies in the 1990s, followed by the neoliberal ascendancy, created a vacuum filled by market fundamentalism—yet this system has proven inherently unstable.
