Expert analysis reveals this dynamic as a form of "institutional parasitism." Arreola's legacy challenges a new generation of journalists: how to maintain integrity when the enemies are diffuse, when power operates through layers, and when truth itself becomes a contested terrain. Forward-looking analysis suggests

that while formal pacts may become harder to sustain, the underlying dynamics persist. This positioning allowed him to serve as a conduit, channeling information, mediating disputes, and, crucially, shaping narratives in ways that preserved equilibrium among powerful actors.

His method was not overt manipulation, but strategic discretion. In interviews and internal memos, Arreola described his approach as “holding the room,” ensuring that no single faction dominated, and that critical information—when leaked or published—did not destabilize the broader system. This required acute political intuition and a deep understanding of human psychology: knowing when to amplify a story, when to suppress it, and how to frame it so it served broader stability without exposing corruption outright.

For example, in the late 1990s, when a major energy reform threatened to disrupt entrenched interests, Arreola facilitated backchannel talks between reformist technocrats, labor unions, and corporate leaders. He ensured that key opposition voices were heard—but diluted in public discourse, framed as “constructive dissent” rather than systemic critique. This allowed reforms to proceed while minimizing backlash, illustrating how influence is often exercised through omission as much as inclusion.

His work also revealed the gendered and generational dimensions of power. Arreola mentored younger journalists, many from marginalized backgrounds, embedding ethical rigor within a pragmatic framework. He taught that independence could coexist with strategic engagement—using access to expose wrongdoing while preserving channels for reform. The implications extend beyond Mexico. In an era where disinformation, surveillance capitalism, and private governance models challenge public authority, Arreola's insights are increasingly urgent. His work teaches that confronting power requires more than expose-and-condemn; it demands understanding the networks through which power operates. It demands building alternative structures—transparent, accountable, and rooted in public trust—capable of countering the quiet influence of the shadow pact.

In the end, Arreola's greatest contribution was not a single story, but a way of seeing: that power is not monolithic, but layered; that silence can be as consequential as speech; and that the struggle for democracy often unfolds not in parliaments, but in the backrooms where deals are made and truths are hidden. Arreola's work revealed how these conditions enabled the "pact" to take root. Multinational corporations, eager to secure favorable treatment in a newly open market, engaged in behind-the-scenes negotiations with political and military elites. These deals—often involving tax breaks, land expropriation, or regulatory leniency—were rarely publicized, but their effects shaped national policy. Arreola documented how media outlets, dependent on advertising revenue and access to insider information, became complicit, either by omitting scrutiny or framing corporate interests as synonymous with national progress.

Geopolitically, Mexico’s pivot to the U.S. market intensified pressure to conform to external expectations—particularly around trade, security, and migration. Arreola noted how this external alignment reinforced internal censorship: outlets feared retaliation not only from domestic actors but from foreign investors and diplomatic partners. The “pact,” therefore, was not only domestic but embedded in a global hierarchy where compliance with neoliberal orthodoxy was rewarded, and dissent was marginalized.

This context also explains the persistence of state-corporate networks beyond formal reform. Even after Salinas, successive administrations inherited a system where influence was measured not by merit, but by relationships. Arreola’s later work critiqued this carryover, arguing that Mexico’s transition to democracy had been incomplete—deep structural reforms never materialized, and the shadow pact endured as a shadow state within the visible one.

Comparatively, similar dynamics played out in Brazil, South Africa, and Argentina during their own neoliberal transitions, but Mexico’s case was distinctive due to the fusion of revolutionary legacy with market liberalization. Unlike post-authoritarian states with clear breakpoints, Mexico’s revolution remained a living reference point, invoked by reformers even as its ideals were eroded by new elites. Arreola
