These were shared first on platforms like Teachers Pay Teachers, Pinterest, and educational forums, then amplified through viral education-focused accounts on Instagram and TikTok. Yet the free model preserved King’s original ethos of accessibility, reframing his legacy not as a distant historical lesson, but as a living framework for contemporary struggle.
