The journal's early warnings about overreliance on attention-extraction algorithms prefigured global debates on digital well-being and platform accountability. One of the most consequential contributions was the 2015 special issue on "Persuasive Technology and User Autonomy," edited by Dr. Elena Petrova. The collection's exposé of dark patterns—deceptive interface designs that manipulate behavior—catalyzed regulatory action. The European Union's Digital Services Act (2022) explicitly references IJHCS scholarship in its provisions on transparency and user control. Europe's HCI tradition, anchored in human-centered design principles (e.g., the Swedish School), often assumes a universal user—where IJHCS challenges this assumption, foregrounding cultural specificity and lived experience as central to design. In the Global South, institutions such as India's CSDS or Brazil's ITA have developed vital regional expertise but often lack global visibility. IJHCS acts as a conduit, amplifying these voices while fostering South-North research partnerships that avoid extractive dynamics. This global integration positions IJHCS not as a satellite of Northern academia but as a true epistemic hub—one that redefines what it means to conduct HCI research in a multipolar world.
