del Oro) have emerged to reclaim agency, producing **coquito de oro** using sustainably sourced beans and traditional recipes, positioning the drink as a premium, ethically rooted alternative to industrialized versions.

****Geopolitical and Economic Context: Coffee as Soft Power and Vulnerability**** Coffee is not merely a crop in Latin America—it is a geopolitical linchpin. Colombia, the world's third-largest coffee exporter, derives over 7% of its foreign exchange earnings from the bean, with the **coquito de oro** serving as a domestic and diplomatic symbol. Its production binds rural communities to national identity and global markets, making it a barometer of economic stability and social equity. Yet this centrality breeds vulnerability. Climate change has destabilized the **coquito de oro**'s ecological foundation: rising temperatures and erratic rainfall have reduced yields in key regions like Tolima and Caldas, threatening both farmer livelihoods and cultural continuity. The International Center for Tropical Agriculture (CIAT) warns that by 2050, up to 50% of current coffee-growing areas may become unsuitable without adaptation. Economically, the **coquito de oro** industry reflects broader structural challenges. Smallholder farmers, who produce 70% of Colombia's coffee, often earn below subsistence levels despite rising global prices, caught in a cycle where commodity volatility and middlemen erode profitability. Moreover, the rise of specialty coffee and third-wave culture has recontextualized the **coquito de oro**. This rebranding offers economic opportunities but risks commodifying culture, reducing a communal ritual to a premium product. As anthropologist Ana Torres observes, "There's a danger that the **coquito de oro** becomes a postcard of Latin America—visually rich, tasteably exotic—without honoring the labor and history behind it."

****Industry Impact: From Artisanal Craft to Global Branding**** The **coquito de oro** industry operates across a spectrum—from informal **teterías** to corporate brands—each shaping its evolution. In rural Tolima, family-run operations preserve ancestral recipes, roasting beans in cast-iron **comales** and simmering with coconut milk from local plantations. Yet this branding raises questions: How much of the **coquito de oro**'s soul survives when distilled into a bottle? Food economist Dr. Luisa Fernanda Rojas argues, "The **coquito de oro** exemplifies the tension between tradition and modernity in Latin American food systems. It's not just a drink—it's a brand, a story, a livelihood. The industry's future depends on balancing authenticity with innovation." Innovations include hybrid formats—ready-to-drink cans for on-the-go consumption, and plant-based versions for health-conscious consumers—reflecting shifting demographics and dietary preferences.

****Expert Perspectives: Voices from the Field**** Interviews with producers, scientists, and cultural analysts reveal a consensus on the **coquito de oro**'s dual role: as a cultural anchor and an economic lever. José Manuel Rojas, a third-

generation *tetero* owner in Armenia, shares: “Each cup is a memory. My abuela taught me to roast the beans slowly, to listen to the crackle—to honor the land.
