Yet the global diffusion of these materials has been uneven, shaped by geopolitical power structures and economic disparities. Platforms like Khan Academy and IXL integrate gamified recognition exercises, embedding cognitive science into scalable technology. In contrast, low- and middle-income countries often rely on low-tech, mass-produced paper worksheets, constrained by infrastructure gaps and limited access to digital tools. In Sub-Saharan Africa, Southeast Asia, and parts of Latin America, the physical worksheet remains the primary mode of early numeracy instruction, yet its effectiveness is compromised by overcrowded classrooms, teacher training deficits, and inconsistent supply chains. Controversially, the dominance of standardized counting worksheets has sparked debates over educational equity and cultural relevance. Critics argue that these tools often reflect a Western epistemological bias—prioritizing rote memorization over contextualized understanding, and uniformity over local knowledge systems. In Indigenous communities across the Americas and Oceania, for example, numerical concepts are embedded in ecological and oral traditions, not grid-based exercises. When imported worksheets replace culturally grounded pedagogies, they risk alienating learners and reinforcing educational colonialism. These efforts highlight a growing tension between market-driven standardization and public good. Expert perspectives reveal a deep divide in the field.
