The genesis of this term is inseparable from the slow unraveling of the 20th-century education model—a monolithic system built on linear progression from secondary school to university, culminating in rigid degree structures. By the early 2000s, globalization, automation, and the rise of knowledge economies began exposing critical fissures: degree inflation without proportional skill alignment, persistent skill mismatches in labor markets, and growing youth disengagement from formal education. In this context, the SNHU Term Start emerged not as a single policy or institution, but as a confluence of decentralized innovation. This transition was neither seamless nor universally embraced. Traditional educators resisted modularity as “diluting education,” while policymakers hesitated to regulate unproven models. Yet pilot programs in community colleges and workforce development centers demonstrated measurable outcomes: higher completion rates among mid-career learners, faster job placement, and reduced time-to-competency. By 2018, the OECD highlighted modular learning as a “disruptive force,” urging governments to modernize credentialing systems.
