The shift was announced via a 47-minute audio-visual piece titled *_Fragmented Selves_*, released on a private blockchain-based platform. The work was not marketed—it was leaked, distributed through encrypted networks and underground art forums. It was met with both awe and skepticism. To some, it was a bold reclamation of artistic agency; to others, another layer of mystification, a continuation of the persona’s deliberate opacity.
