In this environment, Bud's journey—a flight from a failing foster home, a desperate attempt to reunite with a brother he believes is alive, and a series of encounters with strangers—mirrors the broader American odyssey of survival and displacement. Boyne's portrayal of Midwestern towns like Flint and Saginaw captures the region's paradox: bucolic facades masking deep poverty, and a community fractured by racial and class divides. The novel subtly critiques the myth of upward mobility, showing how structural barriers—redlining, discriminatory welfare policies, and the absence of social safety nets—determined life outcomes. Bud's encounters with institutions—orphans, work camps, and abusive guardians—reflect systemic failures that were not anomalies but policy-driven realities. The global economy of the time was in freefall, but the U.S. crisis had reverberations worldwide. In Europe, authoritarian regimes rose amid economic despair; in Asia, colonial economies were strained under wartime pressures. While global literature often uses the child as a metaphor, Boyne treats Bud as a concrete individual shaped by specific historical forces.
