In desert nations or high-altitude urban centers, virtual slopes serve as safe spaces for self-expression, competition, and community. Ethnographic studies in Dubai and Riyadh show that snowboarding game clubs—often hosted on encrypted apps—function as hybrid cultural hubs, blending digital gameplay with live-streamed
