Standardized test scores stagnated, dropout rates in rural and marginalized urban zones rose, and employers reported growing mismatches between graduate skills and labor demands. *Realidades 2* was not merely a curriculum update—it was a recalibration of how knowledge is constructed, transmitted, and validated in a post-pandemic world.
