Editors noted a rise in submissions from younger reporters trained in ethnographic methods, inspired by his fusion of literary craft and investigative rigor. Yet resistance persisted. Some critics dismissed his focus as 'soft' or 'unmarketable,' reflecting deeper anxieties about journalism's role: should it inform, or also heal? Adebowale rejected this binary. Psychologically, the burden was profound. He has spoken of insomnia, emotional numbing, and the isolating toll of bearing witness to widespread suffering without institutional support systems. Yet he persists, framing his work as resistance: ‘To speak the lonely truth is to reclaim dignity. If no one hears, who will?’ Globally, parallels emerge. In South Korea, the 2010s
