The deal, negotiated in secret for weeks, involved a \$100 billion portfolio transfer under emergency regulatory waivers, with JPMorgan assuming all liabilities and critical infrastructure. Crucially, the Federal Reserve provided liquidity injections and facilitated short-term funding, preventing a collapse in interbank markets. This tripartite

coordination—regulators, central bank, and private acquirer—represented a departure from past responses, where political hesitation and institutional silos exacerbated panic.
