Cultural theorist Gita Sen observes that her stories operate as “microcosms of power,” where silence, gesture, and omission become as expressive as dialogue. This stylistic choice, she argues, reflects a deep understanding of Indian epistemologies, where meaning is often encoded in ritual, gesture, and subtext. Murthy’s characters speak less and listen more—not out of passivity, but as a survival tactic in a world where voices are systematically silenced. Controversies surrounding her work are rare but telling. Her

portrayal of caste, though nuanced, has been critiqued by Dalit scholars for insufficient engagement with structural violence, instead emphasizing individual moral failure. This tension reflects a broader debate in Indian literature: whether personal ethics can adequately address systemic oppression. Murthy's response, rooted in her own lived experience, is one of empathy without reductionism—she writes from the margins but refuses to romanticize them.
