Research confirms this limitation. This export of assessment models raises critical questions: Whose literature is privileged? Which interpretive frameworks are normalized? This dynamic reinforces epistemic hierarchies. As scholars like Gayatri Spivak have argued, standardized education often functions as a vehicle of cultural imperialism, where knowledge production is concentrated in a few centers. In countries reforming curricula to include indigenous narratives, such as New Zealand with Māori literature or South Africa with post-apartheid storytelling, resistance emerges: educators demand assessments that honor context, polyphony, and lived experience, not just testable "correctness." International bodies like UNESCO have responded with calls for "culturally responsive assessment," urging flexibility in evaluating literary knowledge. Yet implementation lags. Most national exams still rely on MCQs, reinforcing a narrow, decontextualized view of literacy. The result is a global curriculum that rewards familiarity with standardized content over authentic engagement—eroding the transformative potential of literature as a bridge across

cultures.
