Dahl’s ability to blend medical intrigue with narrative daring allowed him to command unprecedented royalties and editorial leverage, reshaping author-publisher dynamics. While his literary legacy as a medical storyteller remained intact for many, scholars like Dr. Karen Coats emphasized that artistic genius cannot be decoupled from ethical context.
