Its rise is neither accidental nor superficial; it is the product of decades of systemic strain, geopolitical recalibration, and a growing disillusionment with top-down, technocratic interventions that failed to deliver equitable outcomes. The origins of Nawasthi Solutions are deeply embedded in the post-2008 global financial crisis, a period when the fragility of centralized, market-driven development models became unmistakable. In India, the term gained traction in academic and policy circles during the mid-2010s, particularly within think tanks in Delhi, Jaipur, and Varanasi, where scholars observed recurring cycles of crisis—drought-induced rural collapse, urban unemployment spikes, and institutional paralysis in disaster response. This case, among others, became a reference point for a new generation of administrators and activists who questioned the sustainability of top-down development models. The intellectual scaffolding began to solidify in 2015–2016, when scholars from Jawaharlal Nehru University, Tata Institute of Social Sciences, and the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) convened a series of workshops under the banner of “Endogenous Resilience.” These gatherings, often held in remote villages with minimal infrastructure, brought together economists, anthropologists,

engineers, and grassroots leaders. Participants debated the failures of centralized planning, the limits of technocratic solutions, and the potential of indigenous knowledge systems. A pivotal moment came in a 2016 retreat in Bundelkhand, where a farmer from Madhya Pradesh famously asked: “Why must we wait for the state to save us?
