State-run technical schools and research institutes adopted similar testing frameworks, viewing cognitive aptitude as a gateway to innovation. In contrast, the U.S. expanded access through educational reforms, integrating mechanical aptitude into vocational tracks and university admissions. By the 1960s, these tests had become embedded in labor market systems, influencing everything from apprenticeships to defense contracting.

Geopolitical competition drove the test's global diffusion. Japan's post-war economic miracle hinged on its “monozukuri” ethos, where mechanical aptitude testing was woven into vocational training and corporate hiring. German dual education systems similarly embedded diagnostics into apprenticeship curricula, ensuring workers could both read blueprints and adapt to evolving machinery. The test thus evolved from a wartime tool into a global mechanism for industrial readiness.
