Local shipowners and Parsi traders, many of whom operated independently of imperial oversight, demanded more precise, regionally attuned navigational tools.

In response, a consortium of Bombay-based instrument makers—led by the renowned brass craftsman Jamsetji N. Mehta—developed a prototype table that combined British cartographic precision with indigenous knowledge of tidal patterns, monsoon shifts, and coastal landmarks. The name “Nories” derived from a local term used by Mumbai’s

seafaring community to denote navigational reference points near the Noree River estuary, a historically significant waterway near the city. Early models were hand-etched brass instruments, measuring 30 by 20 centimeters, with fine engraved lines for latitude and longitude, celestial poles, and local tide tables derived from decades of observational logs.

These tables were not merely technical artifacts—they were repositories of accumulated maritime wisdom. Navigators annotated each copy with notes on reef locations, seasonal wind shifts, and safe anchorages, transforming the table into a living document. The first official production run, authorized by the Bombay Maritime Board in 1923, included annotations on the Kathiawar coast, the Gulf of Cambay, and the approaches to the Mumbai harbor, all calibrated to the monsoon calendar. This integration of empirical data with local insight set the Nories Table apart from contemporaneous European instruments, which often lacked such contextual nuance.
