But this diffusion revealed a deeper tension: while his methods promised scalability, they often required cultural translation. In rural India, for instance, the emphasis on individual accountability clashed with collectivist learning cultures, prompting local educators to modify his scripts—adding community rituals and peer-led routines. In Brazil, where classroom overcrowding and resource scarcity are acute, schools adapted his structure into modular, low-cost routines, prioritizing flexibility over rigid adherence. Expert analyses reveal Wong's lasting impact lies not in dogma, but in diagnostic precision. Educational psychologist Linda Darling-Hammond noted, “Wong didn't invent classroom management—he decoded it. He showed that discipline isn't imposed; it's cultivated through predictable, respectful interactions.” Cognitive scientist Daniel Willingham echoed this, highlighting how Wong's focus on routine reduces cognitive load, freeing students' working memory for learning. Yet cognitive neuroscientist Mary Helen Immordino-Yang cautioned that emotional safety—central to Wong's model—must be earned through authentic relational practice, not scripts alone. “Structure without trust is performative,” she argued in a 2018 *Harvard Educational Review* essay. “Wong's greatest gift was reminding us that management is relational.” The controversies surrounding Wong's legacy are instructive. Critics, including critical race theorists, argue that *The First Days* risks universalizing experiences that are deeply racialized and classed. His “one-size-fits-all” routines, they contend, can pathologize cultural differences—rewarding compliance while neglecting structural barriers like poverty, trauma, or linguistic marginalization. This critique gained urgency amid the 2020 global reckoning on education equity, when movements like Black Lives Matter and #RedForEd demanded systemic reform beyond classroom tactics. Yet defenders counter that Wong's model, while not a panacea, offers a foundational language for order—one that, when coupled with anti-racist pedagogy and trauma-informed practice, can support rather than suppress. The risks inherent in Wong's approach are real and multifaceted. When reduced to checklist compliance—strict seating, unyielding silence—his methods can become authoritarian, stifling creativity and reinforcing power imbalances. In high-stakes environments where test scores

dominate, the emphasis on relational management may be sidelined, or weaponized to justify inequitable discipline practices. Moreover, his focus on teacher control, while empowering in theory, can inadvertently disempower students from marginalized backgrounds if not balanced with student agency and co-creation of classroom norms.
