These differences reflect broader cultural attitudes toward state authority, individual rights, and technological trust.

Expert perspectives: literacy, equity, and ethical boundaries

A 2021 study by the Center for Digital Rights found that exam algorithms disproportionately flagged users with neurodivergent profiles or low digital fluency—leading to higher failure rates not due to knowledge gaps, but system design flaws. This underscores a critical challenge: how to build equitable assessment frameworks that recognize diverse learning styles and lived experiences.

Controversies and risks: surveillance, exclusion, and data exploitation
