Critics argue that qualitative depth is sometimes sacrificed for quantifiable metrics, risking reductionism. The authors respond by defending sociology’s interpretive strength—its ability to uncover meaning behind numbers, to humanize trends obscured by big data. They advocate for methodological pluralism, where ethnography, discourse analysis, and statistical modeling coexist.

Controversies and Risks: When Sociology Meets Power

Sociology’s critical edge has always invited resistance. From Marxist accusations of ideological bias to libertarian critiques of “elitist” academic detachment, the discipline walks a tightrope between independence and influence. The thirteenth edition confronts these tensions head-on. One major controversy centers on the perceived politicization of sociological research.
