These entities do not simply fund infrastructure; they embed their governance philosophies into the very code that runs urban systems. Internal documents leaked in 2022 reveal that Simplicity Forum’s working groups began formalizing a “Data Sovereignty Protocol” in 2019—an initiative ostensibly designed to protect citizen privacy. Independent audits by the Urban Justice Institute found that 68% of Forum-driven projects in the Global South lack meaningful community input, with displacement and privacy concerns routinely overridden by “data optimization” imperatives. Controversies have mounted.
