The Iraq War (2003) and subsequent intelligence failures shattered public confidence; the 2008 financial crisis exposed systemic opacity; and the rise of populist movements leveraged disinformation to delegitimize established narratives. These fractures created fertile ground for competing truth regimes. Governments, recognizing the threat to national cohesion, began crafting regulatory responses—from the EU's Digital Services Act to India's IT Amendments—aimed at holding platforms accountable for harmful content propagation. These efforts reflect a recognition that information dominance is a strategic asset. Yet even in closed systems, the global reach of digital platforms limits isolation—disinformation flows across borders, forcing even closed societies to adapt. In the Global South, the controversy intersects with development challenges. Limited media infrastructure, low digital literacy, and economic dependence on foreign platforms amplify vulnerability. Nigeria, Indonesia, and India have experienced election-related disinformation surges, often exploiting ethnic, religious, and regional fault lines.
