Trade dynamics further complicate equity. In high-income nations, governments subsidize curriculum development, enabling rich multimedia worksheets with embedded videos and interactive prompts. In contrast, low-income countries often rely on donor-funded materials, which may lack contextual adaptation or suffer from outdated pedagogical models. The result is a fragmented global landscape: while innovation flourishes in some contexts, systemic gaps persist where infrastructure, funding, and

policy coherence remain weak.
