They observed that children from rural villages processed information differently than urban elites—faster in oral traditions, more attuned to communal learning, less responsive to abstract instruction. These insights prefigured later educational psychology concepts such as multiple intelligences and social constructivism, but were framed within a pre-independence discourse of cultural dignity and self-determination. The partition of 1947 and the subsequent creation of Pakistan intensified these tensions. The new state inherited a fractured education system, with stark disparities between East and West Pakistan. In the western province—modern-day Pakistan—education was further strained by mass migration, linguistic fragmentation (Urdu vs. regional

languages), and a shortage of trained teachers. Amid this chaos, early educational psychologists like Dr. Hamiduddin Ahmed, a pioneering figure in South Asian education, argued that effective nation-building required more than infrastructure; it demanded a science of the learner. Ahmed's lectures at Aligarh Muslim University and later at the University of Punjab emphasized that teaching was not merely transmission, but a psychological process shaped by emotion, culture, and lived experience. He championed the idea that understanding a child's developmental stage, family background, and social environment was essential for meaningful learning—a radical notion in a system still steeped in authoritarian discipline. Yet, institutionalization of educational psychology in Urdu contexts remained limited. Colonial-era teacher training colleges focused on pedagogy and curriculum, not psychology.
