Local journalists documented illegal clearances and community resistance but faced censorship. A coalition of Odia activists and independent reporters launched a parallel digital archive, embedding GPS data, oral histories, and legal documents into a public platform. This act of “story rebating” transformed a local environmental conflict into a national debate on land rights and democratic accountability.
