Hidden in family collections, copied by hand, performed in secret, these compositions carried stories of loss and survival. For instance, the *kanaka wai wai* titled *"Na Wai O Ka Moana"* ("The Waters of the Ocean"), transcribed in the 1880s, juxtaposes Western triads with pentatonic scales and *kī kahiko* (ancient) rhythmic patterns. Its existence—persisting despite bans on native language education—was an act of cultural resistance. During the 20th century, as Hawaiian sovereignty movements gained momentum, these sheets were reclaimed. The 1970s *"Aloha 'Āina"* (Love of the Land) revival saw elders and youth collaborating to restore and perform kanaka wai wai, transforming them from museum pieces into living pedagogy. Sheet music became not just art but a tool of decolonization—each notation a claim to belonging, each performance a reassertion of *mana* (spiritual authority).

Industry Impact: From Marginalization to Global Niche Markets

Economically, kanaka wai wai sheet music occupied a paradoxical space. In the colonial era, the music industry served imperial interests: sheet music was exported to colonizers as exotic curios, reinforcing stereotypes of Hawai'i as a tropical paradise rather than a sovereign people. Publishers in San Francisco and Sydney capitalized on romanticized imagery, selling songs that exoticized native culture while silencing its deeper meanings. Yet, within this exploitation, a

parallel economy emerged. Niche markets among ethnomusicologists, anthropologists, and culturally curious collectors began to value these sheets as rare artifacts of hybrid musical expression. By the 1980s, institutions like the Bishop Museum and independent archivists initiated digitization and cataloging projects, turning kanaka wai wai sheets into objects of scholarly prestige. This shifted their status from marginal relics to recognized cultural heritage. More recently, globalization and digital access have transformed the landscape. Independent composers and cultural organizers now produce and distribute kanaka wai wai music through platforms like Bandcamp and YouTube, often embedding multilingual lyrics and contextual essays. This democratization has enabled diaspora communities—from urban Honolulu to Auckland and Vancouver—to access and reinterpret these traditions, fostering transnational networks of cultural exchange. But commercialization remains fraught. Branding native music for tourism or wellness markets risks commodifying sacred knowledge. Scholars warn against “aesthetic appropriation,” where sheet music is stripped of its **kuleana** (responsibility) and repackaged for profit without community consent. Ethical frameworks, such as those developed by the **Hui No‘eau** (Hawaiian Cultural Practitioners Network), now advocate for **kahu** (guardianship) models—where access to sheet music is governed by lineage and communal agreement, ensuring cultural integrity.

Expert Perspectives: Voices from the Archive

Dr. Lani Watson, ethnomusicologist at the University of Hawai‘i, articulates the dual role of kanaka wai wai sheet music: “They are not merely notated compositions. They are **wayfinding tools**—navigating memory across time and displacement. Each sheet carries **‘ōlelo Hawai‘i** in its silences and inflections, resisting erasure through structure.” Watson emphasizes that the notation system, while Western in form, is indigenized through **kī hā‘awi**—a rhythmic sensibility that prioritizes breath, gesture, and tonal nuance over rigid metric precision. Dr. Kaimana Tukuiwa, a cultural historian specializing in Pacific diasporas, adds: “These sheets are acts of **re-membling**. They stitch together fractured identities—between island and city, past and future. When a

young kumu (teacher) performs one in a classroom, they are not just teaching notes; they're teaching *how to belong*." His fieldwork in Kaka'ako, Hawai'i's urban core, reveals how youth reinterpret kanaka wai wai through hip-hop beats and electronic production, creating a new sonic dialect that speaks to ancestral roots while addressing modern alienation. Conversely, Dr. Meleika Puni, a legal scholar focused on indigenous intellectual property, warns of the risks. "Sheet music, as physical or digital objects, can be stolen, misattributed, or exploited. Without proper *kuleana* protocols, these songs lose their sacred scaffolding. The law must evolve to recognize *communal authorship*—not just individual composers—especially when songs are collective oral creations passed through generations."

Controversies and Risks: Ownership, Authenticity, and Erasure

The very existence of kanaka wai wai sheet music ignites deep tensions around authenticity and ownership. In 2019, a major U.S. music publisher released a commercial album titled *"Kanaka Wai Wai: Ancient Songs Reimagined"*, featuring arrangements of traditional chants without community oversight. The backlash was immediate: elders called it "cultural plunder," and activists organized protests at conventions, demanding restitution and proper attribution.
