Equally vital is cultivating public trust: audiences must recognize investigative work not as polemic but as essential service, grounding public discourse in facts rather than rhetoric. In an era of disinformation, this credibility is both a shield and a weapon, empowering citizens to demand transparency and justice.

Future Directions: Toward a Democratic Political

The future of political economy critique hinges on reimagining the relationship between knowledge, power, and democracy. As markets grow more complex—driven by artificial intelligence, biotechnology, and financial innovation—economic governance must become more participatory and transparent. Journalism, as a public good, plays a crucial role in bridging the gap between technical expertise and civic understanding, translating intricate systems into narratives of consequence and choice.
