Western regulators, particularly the U.S. FDA, grew increasingly wary of quality control lapses, leading to high-profile import alerts and facility inspections. Shankar immerses the reader in the aftermath of

the 2018 FDA warning letter to a major Indian API manufacturer—an event that triggered a cascade of plant shutdowns, delayed drug approvals, and a recalibration of global supply dependencies. This geopolitical tension is amplified by the U.S.-China rivalry, which Shankar situates within pharmaceutical supply chains. The pandemic laid bare the perils of overreliance on single-source manufacturing, especially for active pharmaceutical ingredients (APIs). China dominates API production—accounting for over 80% of global supply—yet geopolitical instability, export restrictions, and quality concerns prompted a push for “friend-shoring” and onshoring. Shankar critiques the rush to decouple, warning that fragmented regulatory standards and duplicated compliance burdens may inflate drug prices and delay access, particularly for life-saving therapies in LMICs.

Economic Engineering: The Hidden Costs of Innovation

The book’s economic critique cuts to the heart of pharmaceutical capitalism. Shankar dismantles the myth of R&D return on investment by exposing how industry-funded trials systematically overstate efficacy and understate adverse events. Drawing on leaked internal memos and whistleblower testimonies, he documents how trial endpoints are strategically chosen—often favoring surrogate markers over clinically

meaningful outcomes—to engineer regulatory approval. For instance, a cancer drug may be approved based on tumor shrinkage in a narrow timeframe, even if overall survival remains unchanged. This “numerics theater” allows companies to secure patent protection and premium pricing, regardless of real-world impact. Compounding this, Shankar analyzes the role of patent thickets and evergreening—tactics used to extend market exclusivity beyond original approvals. He traces how minor molecular tweaks, often clinically trivial, are patented to block generic competition. This practice, prevalent in oncology and rare diseases, inflates drug costs to unsustainable levels, particularly in the U.S., where list prices for specialty drugs have risen 12-fold since 2000. The book reveals how payers, insurers, and even governments are ensnared in a cycle of escalating prices, with little leverage to negotiate due to complex patent portfolios and regulatory safeguards. Yet, Shankar does not paint a monolithic picture of villainy. He highlights reformist actors: progressive regulators in the EU and Canada who are adopting real-world evidence (RWE) frameworks to supplement traditional trials; patient advocacy groups demanding transparency; and open science initiatives pushing for preprint archives of clinical data. These efforts, though nascent, signal a potential rupture in the status quo—one where accountability and access are prioritized over unchecked innovation.
