South Korea combines rigorous workbook practice with high-stakes testing, producing strong grammatical accuracy but high student stress. In contrast, Brazil’s national curriculum integrates tenses within broader socio-cultural contexts—such as discussing historical events in past tense or envisioning

community futures—embedding grammar in lived experience. These models suggest that effective tense instruction must be culturally situated, developmentally appropriate, and cognitively engaging. Looking forward, the future of tenses worksheets is being reshaped by artificial intelligence and neuro-educational research.
