Pettus has responded by embedding community educators within its operations—hosting free workshops on estate planning, advance directives, and financial literacy. Pettus, while rooted in Black Baptist tradition, has adapted by offering multilingual staff and culturally sensitive support, signaling a quiet globalization within local deathways. This hybridization suggests a future where funeral homes are not just repositories of
