This tension is not abstract; it plays out in real time through disagreements over climate change, migration, and LGBTQ+ inclusion, where regional bishops demand urgent action, while Rome weighs doctrinal boundaries. Controversies surrounding sexual abuse and cover-ups have further fractured the faith family, exposing systemic failures in accountability.
