What followed was not just automation but a redefinition of labor, value, and authorship in the digital economy. Traditional revenue models—subscriptions, donations, advertising—are undermined when platforms distribute AI content at near-zero marginal cost. This has accelerated the “race to the bottom,” where quality journalism is increasingly a luxury, and survival depends on scale and algorithmic favor. Regulatory responses have been fragmented: the EU’s Digital Services Act

imposes transparency requirements on AI-generated content but lacks enforcement teeth; India's IT Rules mandate watermarking of AI-generated material but struggle with compliance. The report framed it as “intensive” not just in output but in process—24/7 training, real-time feedback loops, and adaptive learning—making it “free” in economic terms despite massive infrastructure costs. By mid-2021, the term entered Silicon Valley discussions, particularly at AI-for-content conferences in San Francisco and Singapore, where entrepreneurs pitched “Intensive 21 Gratis” as the next frontier in digital publishing. Its evolution followed three distinct phases. Phase one (2021–2022) was exploratory: startups experimented with basic LLMs, human-AI collaboration models, and automated fact-checking tools.
