This was not merely an adjustment to realism; it was a reorientation toward what she termed “embedded power theory”—a framework asserting that states act as economic actors first, and as military or diplomatic agents second, with power defined by the capacity to shape and control global resource distributions.

Evolution Through Decades: Theories in Dialogue and Conflict

Hudson’s theoretical evolution mirrored the tectonic shifts in global order—from the end of the Cold War’s illusion of liberal convergence, through the rise of China, the fracturing of multilateral institutions, and the reassertion of great power competition. This synthesis—realist materialism tempered by institutional and ideational dynamics—marked a rare theoretical maturation, positioning Hudson at the vanguard of integrative international relations theory.

The 1970s stagflation and oil crises revealed vulnerabilities in Western industrial models; the 1980s debt crises in Latin America underscored financial dependencies. In contrast, industrial democracies, while constrained by domestic accountability, face internal fragmentation in great power competition due to lobbying, public sentiment, and institutional inertia. Her “power asymmetry matrix” (PAM), developed in collaboration with economists at the Brookings Institution, quantifies these dynamics, showing how economic structure determines not just capability, but strategic patience and policy coherence.

Industry and Institutional Impact: From Academia to Policy Influence

Valerie Hudson's influence transcended academia. Her embedded power framework was adopted by the U.S. Department of Defense's Strategic Planning Office in the 2000s, informing counterinsurgency doctrine by

emphasizing control over revenue flows in conflict zones. Controversies and Critiques: The Limits of Economic Determinism

Despite her stature, Hudson's work has faced significant criticism. Critics argue that her emphasis on economic leverage risks reducing complex geopolitical phenomena to material calculations, underestimating the role of ideology, charismatic leadership, and historical contingency. Political realists, particularly those aligned with the Washington School, have accused her of overstating systemic determinism, suggesting her framework flattens state agency and moral choice. Moreover, her predictions about China's rise, while grounded in structural analysis, were questioned in light of persistent U.S. technological advantages

through 2020. Critics note that state capitalism, while potent, faces internal contradictions—demographic decline, debt burdens, and institutional inertia—that Hudson’s model struggles to fully capture. Others point to the resilience of democratic alliances like NATO, which defy simple economic logic, suggesting identity and shared values remain decisive. Yet Hudson herself acknowledged these tensions, refining her PAM in 2018 to include “adaptive governance” as a mediating variable—where institutional flexibility allows states to overcome economic constraints through innovation and coalition-building.
