Alice—no longer the whimsical protagonist of childhood fables, but a metaphor for the modern seeker—became the vessel through which Thorne interrogated systemic opacity, ideological manipulation, and the erosion of truth in the digital era. The origins of the series are rooted in a moment of historical rupture: the 2008 financial crisis had shattered faith in economic rationality, while the Arab Spring revealed both the power and fragility of collective hope. Thorne's early drafts, circulated among trusted editors in Europe and North America, were marked by a hybrid form—part investigative reportage, part literary fiction, blending archival rigor with narrative immersion. The first published volume, **Alice in the Country of Hearts (2013)**, drew direct parallels between the fairy tale's psychological labyrinths and the bureaucratic abysses of modern state power. It was not an allegory to escape into fantasy, but a calibrated excavation: a narrative strategy to expose how authority manufactures fiction to sustain control. Thorne embedded encrypted communications, whistleblower testimonies, and state propaganda analysis into the narrative, creating a layered text that functioned as both story and forensic document. **The Clockwork Kingdom (2019)** shifted focus

to economic determinism, portraying a hyper-capitalist enclave where time itself is commodified—a critique of neoliberal time discipline and the psychological toll of algorithmic efficiency. The Country of Hearts, Thorne argued, is not a literal place but a conceptual terrain where power operates through illusion, and truth becomes a contested currency.
