For Palestinian Christians, Christmas is deeply intertwined with identity—both religious and national. With Christian communities now constituting less than 2% of the West Bank population, the holiday serves as a public affirmation of presence. McCutcheon documents how families in Beit Jala and Beit Sahour prepare for Christmas Eve with meticulous care, often sourcing trees from neighboring Jordan or importing them via informal routes through Egypt, circumventing Israeli checkpoints. The tree itself becomes a symbol: often stand-in trunks of olive trees, their branches representing both heritage and resistance. Religious leaders emphasize that Christmas is not merely a feast of saints but a celebration of endurance. Bishop Elias Haddad of Bethlehem explains: ‘Our celebration is not about miracles. It’s about showing up—here, now, in this land.’ This theological framing deepens the holiday’s significance beyond festivity. It is a spiritual assertion that the Christian presence in Palestine is not transient but rooted in centuries of coexistence. McCutcheon’s interviews with youth reveal a complex relationship: many feel proud of their heritage but also burdened by its fragility. One [redacted] in Hebron confided, ‘We celebrate Christmas like it’s a war—every candle is a claim, every gift a reminder we still exist.’ This interplay of faith and identity transforms the holiday into a living narrative of survival.

Economic Realities and the Material Constraints of Celebration

While Western Christmas is often associated with abundance, in Palestinian territories, the material conditions of celebration expose stark disparities. The World Bank reports that over 60% of Palestinian households live below the national poverty line, with youth unemployment

exceeding 40% in Gaza. This economic reality reshapes the holiday's expression. McCutcheon's reporting reveals a culture of improvisation: families exchange handmade crafts for food, share electric generators among neighbors, and repurpose scrap metal into ornaments. A family in Jabalia described how they crafted a tree from discarded wires and plastic bottles, illuminated by solar-powered lights—'not because we have much,' one mother said, 'but because we want to show our children that joy isn't dependent on what you buy.'

Industrial supply chains have all but collapsed in Gaza, where electricity is limited to 12 hours daily and import restrictions strangle commerce. As a result, local artisans have become central to the holiday economy. McCutcheon profiles a network of women in Khan Younis who knit woolen scarves, carve wooden crèches from olive wood, and bake traditional sweets like maamoul using family recipes passed down generations. These crafts not only sustain tradition but create micro-economies in areas where formal work is scarce. However, scarcity also breeds tension—access to materials is uneven, and smuggling routes are fraught with risk. The journalist notes that a single shortage of batteries can delay a family's lighting ceremony by weeks. This material precarity forces a redefinition of generosity: gift-giving becomes less about quantity and more about symbolic value, emphasizing presence over possessions.

Security Risks and the Journalistic Dilemma

Embedded with troops and embedded in communities, McCutcheon's reporting confronts the ever-present danger of Christmas in contested zones. In 2023, during a Christmas Eve service in Hebron's Old City, a mortar round struck a building just 50 meters away, shattering windows and sending panic through the congregation. McCutcheon details how journalists operating in these zones face dual risks: physical exposure

and ethical complexity. Embedded with Israeli forces, he witnessed firsthand how curfews and checkpoints restrict movement—Christmas Eve gatherings were often delayed or canceled at the last minute due to ‘operational security.’ In one incident, a journalist was detained for three hours while covering a midnight service in Silwan, accused of ‘aiding enemy forces’ based on a misinterpreted gesture.

These incidents underscore a broader paradox: the very act of documenting Christmas under occupation becomes a high-stakes performance. McCutcheon emphasizes that reporters rely on local fixers—trusted community members who navigate checkpoints and negotiate access. Yet even with these networks, uncertainty looms. In Gaza, where Israeli airstrikes have intensified since 2021, journalists report avoiding certain neighborhoods during peak tension periods, delaying publication until risks subside. The psychological toll is significant—chronic exposure to violence, the pressure to report accurately amid chaos, and the moral weight of bearing witness without intervening. McCutcheon reflects: ‘To capture Christmas in the trenches is not just about storytelling; it’s about survival—both ours and theirs.’ This reality challenges journalistic norms, demanding a balance between immediacy and safety, truth and consequence.

Global Comparisons: Christmas in War-Torn and Occupied Territories

Christmas in conflict zones is not unique to Palestine, but its manifestations vary across contexts, revealing shared patterns and distinct adaptations. In Ukraine, since 2014, Christmas has become a geopolitical stage—Moscow frames celebrations in occupied regions as propaganda, while Kyiv uses them to rally international support. In Syria, war-torn Aleppo sees churches open only after months of negotiation,

with families gathering in bombed-out shells illuminated by flickering candles. In Yemen, where famine and blockade prevail, Christmas is often a quiet, intimate affair—children sharing a single date, elders reading the nativity in Arabic, a testament to endurance amid collapse.

McCutcheon draws a critical distinction: in Western narratives, Christmas in conflict zones is often romanticized or treated as exotic spectacle. But in Palestine, the holiday is deeply embedded in daily resistance—celebrations are not escapes but affirmations. A journalist comparing Bethlehem to Gaza notes: ‘In Ukraine, Christmas may symbolize resilience, but in Palestine, it is survival itself—every candle lit is a claim.’ This contrast highlights how local history, occupation dynamics, and cultural identity shape ritual. While Christmas in Ukraine functions as a rallying cry for sovereignty, in Palestine it is a reclamation of presence—where the act of gathering, lighting a tree, or reading the story is an assertion that life persists beneath siege.

Expert Perspectives: Psychology and Sociology of Ritual in Conflict

Psychologists and sociologists consulted in McCutcheon’s research underscore the therapeutic and social functions of Christmas traditions in war zones. Dr. Layla Al-Najjar, a clinical psychologist specializing in trauma in occupied territories, explains: ‘Rituals like Christmas provide a structured moment of normalcy—something our brains crave in environments of unpredictability. They activate memory, reduce cortisol levels, and foster social cohesion, which is vital for mental health.’ Her studies show that children who participate in consistent holiday rituals exhibit lower rates of anxiety and PTSD symptoms, even in high-stress environments.

Sociologist Dr. Omar Farouk notes that these traditions also serve as counter-narratives to dominant violence. ‘In Gaza, where media often focuses on destruction, Christmas becomes a counterpoint—evidence of joy, family, and continuity,’ he states. This cultural resistance is not passive; it is active, redefining public space through light, sound, and shared narrative. McCutcheon’s interviews with community leaders confirm that such rituals strengthen intergenerational bonds—grandparents teaching children traditional songs, parents mentoring youth in craft-making—ensuring that cultural memory endures beyond physical displacement.

Controversies and Ethical Tensions

Despite their symbolic power, Christmas celebrations in conflict zones are not without controversy. In Bethlehem, tensions flare when local Christian leaders oppose the commercialization of the holiday by foreign media and tourists, viewing it as exploitation. Some elders criticize the influx of Western-style decorations as diluting authentic tradition, while youth embrace global influences, creating generational friction. McCutcheon documents debates over funding: international NGOs sometimes impose top-down ‘holiday packages’—ornaments, trees, and gift baskets—disrupting organic community practices.

Ethically, journalists face dilemmas in balancing visibility and vulnerability. Publishing images of children in rubble during celebrations risks sensationalism, yet withholding them may erase the reality of suffering. McCutcheon adheres to a strict editorial code: consent, context, and minimizing harm. He recounts a moment in Gaza where a family declined to be photographed, citing fear of reprisal—his decision honored that trust, even if it meant a page going unprinted.

Industry Impact: Media, Tourism, and Cultural Commodification

While Christmas in Palestinian territories remains largely uncommercialized, its media portrayal has influenced global perceptions and, to a limited extent, tourism. Since 2020, foreign correspondents like McCutcheon have brought renewed attention to Bethlehem's holiday scenes, boosting niche travel to Christian pilgrimage sites. However, this exposure is carefully managed—local authorities restrict access to sensitive areas, and NGOs coordinate with communities to ensure dignity, not spectacle.

The industry impact extends beyond tourism. McCutcheon observes that digital platforms have enabled grassroots storytelling—local Palestinians livestreaming services, sharing recipes, and posting reflections, reaching millions. This shift from passive consumption to participatory narrative challenges Western media's traditional gatekeeping. As McCutcheon notes, 'The holiday is no longer just reported from outside—it is now co-authored by those living it.' This democratization of storytelling empowers marginalized voices, though it also raises questions about authenticity and exploitation in an era of viral content.

Global Comparisons: Comparative Resilience and Cultural Adaptation

Across conflict zones, Christmas traditions reveal a spectrum of adaptation. In Ukraine, families in Kyiv celebrate under blackout conditions, using candles and solar lights—mirroring Palestinian ingenuity but driven by defensive militarization rather than occupation. In Syria's war-ravaged areas, churches in Aleppo hold services in reinforced

shelters, with families sharing meager rations, blending religious observance with survival. In Yemen, where Christmas is rare, small communities in Aden hold low-key gatherings, emphasizing quiet solidarity.
