Napster’s 1999 launch, powered by MP3s, became the flashpoint—its peer-to-peer network allowed millions to exchange music outside licensed channels. The RIAA responded with aggressive litigation, targeting users and ISPs alike. Yet enforcement proved futile; the platform’s decentralized nature and exponential user growth rendered legal suppression ineffective. The Napster case became a global legal litmus test, exposing tensions between copyright enforcement and digital freedom. Meanwhile, in the European Union, regulators approached the MP3’s diffusion with ambivalence. The EU’s 1995 Telecommunications Package encouraged digital innovation but also emphasized consumer rights and access. Countries like Germany and France embraced MP3-

enabled music sharing as a symbol of digital emancipation, resisting heavy-handed censorship. This contrasts sharply with China, where the MP3's utility in circumventing state media controls drew both popular use and official scrutiny. In the 2000s, Chinese netizens employed MP3-sharing via encrypted protocols to bypass the Great Firewall, illustrating how the format became a tool of informational resistance. Thus, the MP3's global spread was not uniform—it was shaped by local political economies, internet governance models, and the balance between innovation and control.

Economic Disruption: The Collapse of Physical Media and the Birth of Streaming

The MP3's most visible impact was economic: the unraveling of a \$40+ billion global recorded music industry built on physical sales. By 2023, streaming accounted for 83% of global recorded music revenue, per IFPI. The MP3's compression efficiency made high-volume, low-latency streaming feasible—without it, the real-time playback demanded by modern users would be technically unviable on constrained networks.
