Historical records show police missed key connections, partly due to Gacy's reputation as a "good citizen." A 2020 analysis in *Crime & Delinquency* highlights how reliance on familial ties and community goodwill obscured red flags. This systemic lapse led to the creation of specialized "serial killer task forces."
