of years of diplomatic tension and military planning. Austria's ultimatum to Serbia, backed by Germany's "blank check," transformed a regional dispute into a continental emergency. Russia's partial mobilization in support of Serbia triggered Germany's declaration of war on Russia, followed by France's commitment to defend Russia—activating a chain reaction of mutual defense pacts. The industrial dimension of the conflict cannot be overstated. The war of 1914–1918 was the first true industrial war, with armies equipped with machine guns, artillery, poison gas, and early tanks.
